1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       **SECTION 1. SEPARATE DATES FOR CELEBRATION OF MAR-**  
4                       **TIN LUTHER KING, JR. DAY AND INAUGURA-**  
5                       **TION DAY.**

6       Section 6103 of title 5, United States Code, is  
7       amended—

1           (1) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-  
2       section (e); and

3           (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-  
4       lowing:

5       “(d) Notwithstanding subsection (a), if by operation  
6       of subsection (c) Inauguration Day will be observed on the  
7       legal public holiday for the Birthday of Martin Luther  
8       King, Jr., then the date for the Birthday of Martin Luther  
9       King, Jr. under such subsection (a) shall be the Tuesday  
10      following the third Monday in January.”.
